

Libraries are for everyone

Gympie Regional Libraries are committed to providing a welcoming, inclusive, respectful and safe environment for library members, visitors and staff.

Everyone who uses Gympie Regional Libraries' services and facilities must abide by the following:

- Behave in a manner which does not harass, disrupt, interfere, offend or obstruct other persons or library operations.
- Treat Library staff and other Library users with courtesy and respect. Aggressive or abusive behaviour will not be tolerated.
- Abide by any reasonable directions given by Library staff.
- Be responsible for the safety of their own personal belongings.
- Children under the age of twelve must be supervised at all times by a responsible adult.
- Understand that parents, guardians or carers are responsible for the welfare and behaviour of the person in their care, and for supervising their selection and use of all Library resources.
- Treat Library facilities, equipment, and property with due care, including not vandalizing, defacing, destroying or damaging Library facilities, equipment, and property.
- Appropriate dress is required, including wearing of footwear and a shirt/top.
- Obtain consent from Library staff before undertaking any photography, video recording, or live online streaming, on Library premises.
- Users must not canvass for any purpose or distribute handbills, advertisements, petitions or other notices in the library.
- Only registered assistance animals are permitted in the library.

Gympie Regional Libraries staff have the right to ask any person to leave the facility if they do not comply with these Conditions of Entry.

Dangerous or unlawful behaviour will be reported to the Queensland Police Service.
